The Logan County Education Foundation held its annual meeting in the Indian Lake Elementary cafeteria the evening of September 21. Mike Wallace presided over the business meeting. Committee chairs reviewed the previous year's accomplishments during the meeting. 2010-2011 successes include establishing a new endowment to award a scholarship to Indian Lake students, awarding 13 teacher grants totaling over \$5,600.00 and 24 scholarships totaling over \$35,000.00. Many thanks to the volunteers from Riverside Schools who assisted with the event. This year's event netted just over \$4,500.00.

Donor Celebration Event

The 14th Logan County Education Foundation donor event was held September 28 at Chattan Loch. The event began as a biennial dinner at the Ohio Caverns in 1990. In 2004 it became an annual event that highlights a teacher grants and student musical talent from the four school districts in Logan County.

This year, attendees were entertained by two Benjamin Logan student pianists.

Mary Rutan Hospital was awarded the LCEF Award of Excellence for being a long time sponsor of the LCEF Run to Educate. Not only has Mary Rutan supported the Foundation financially, they currently have four employees sharing their time and talents as LCEF trustees representing 3 of the 4 school districts.

Students will work as a team with our visiting artist, teachers, and community members to create a mural made from plastic bottle caps and lids, while being inspired to utilize this inexpensive and creative outlet by creating artwork from recyclable materials."

The grant provided for an artist in residence to work with the students and staff for 2 days.
