This is the first month of our new operating year. We will begin our new year by reviewing the accomplishments of the past one.

### TEACHER GRANTS

The LCEF awarded 6 dedicated teacher grants totaling \$3500.00 and another \$2176.00 in LCEF funded classroom grants.

### RUN TO EDUCATE

Another year with record participation! There were 148 preregistered runners and another 57 registered the day of the Run. Logan County Electric Cooperative was our corporate sponsor once again. Our T-shirt sponsors were Mary Rutan Hospital, Brentlinger and Associates, Zimmerman Realty, Aries HealthMart, Thomas & Marker Construction Co., and Kemba Credit Union. The race volunteers were from the Indian Lake Schools. Nearly \$4000.00 was raised for Foundation projects such as the teacher grant program.

### DONOR CELEBRATION BANQUET

The banquet was held September 22 at Chattan Loch Bistro and Public House. Attendees enjoyed heavy hors d' oeuvres and background music provided by Indian Lake High School student, Shane Arnett. After dinner, Bill Shepard was awarded the LCEF Leadership Award and Jeanine Jackson was recognized for her years of service as a trustee. Indian Lake Elementary School teachers Pam Scarpella and Susie Grant presented a program about the Edward Core Jr. Grant they received and implemented during the 2009- 10 school year.

### EARNING FOR LEARNING

Our annual fund drive netted over \$8800.00 from our generous contributors. The donations enable the Logan County Education Foundation to continue our mission of supporting educational excellence in our community.

### SCHOLARSHIPS

Logan County Education Foundation awarded 24 scholarships totaling over \$35,000.00 to Logan County students this spring. Three scholarships funded by the Fuson—Buroker Memorial Fund Endowment were awarded for the first time. The new Debbie Ellis Academic Scholarship fund awarded it's first scholarship.
